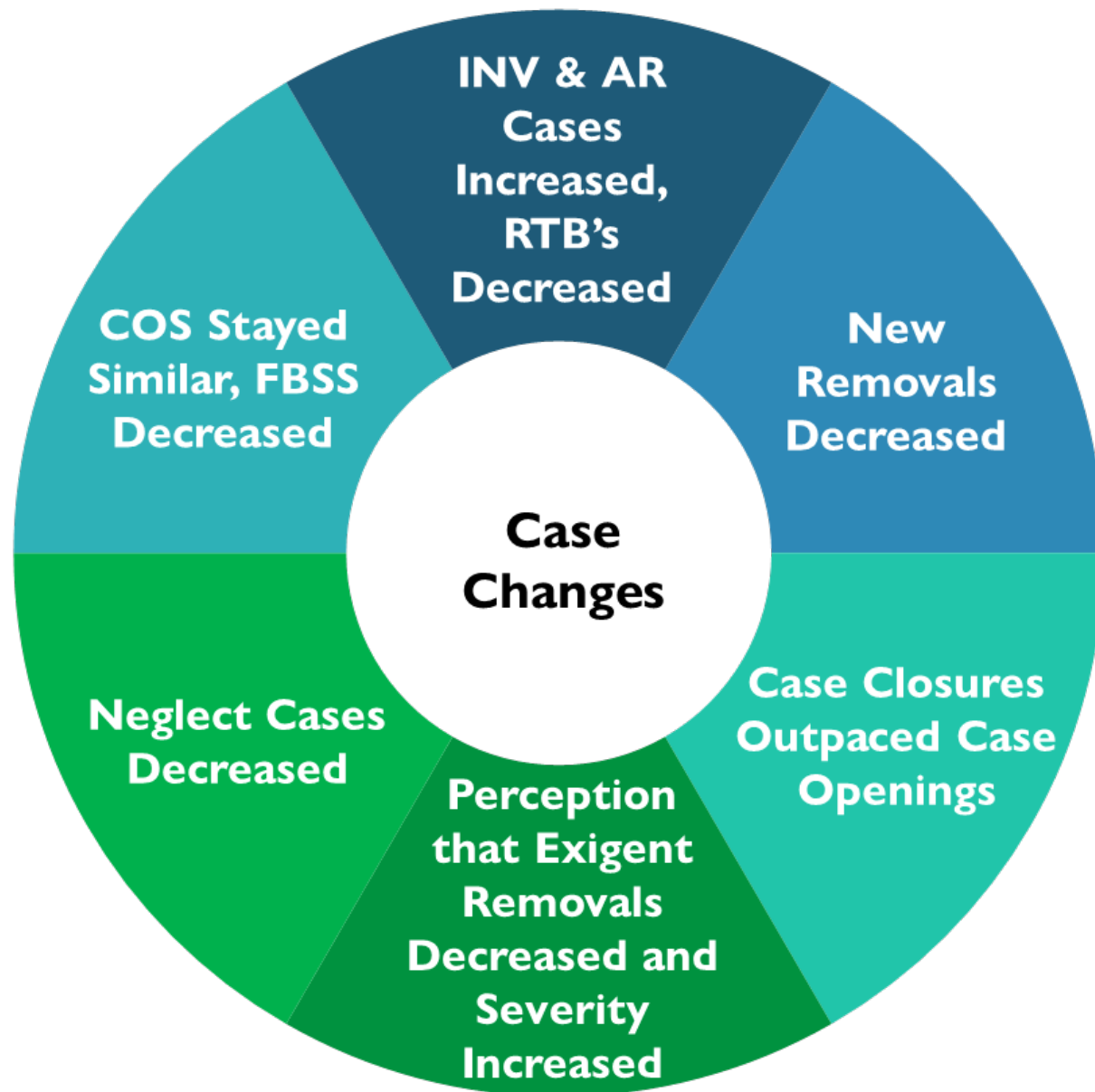

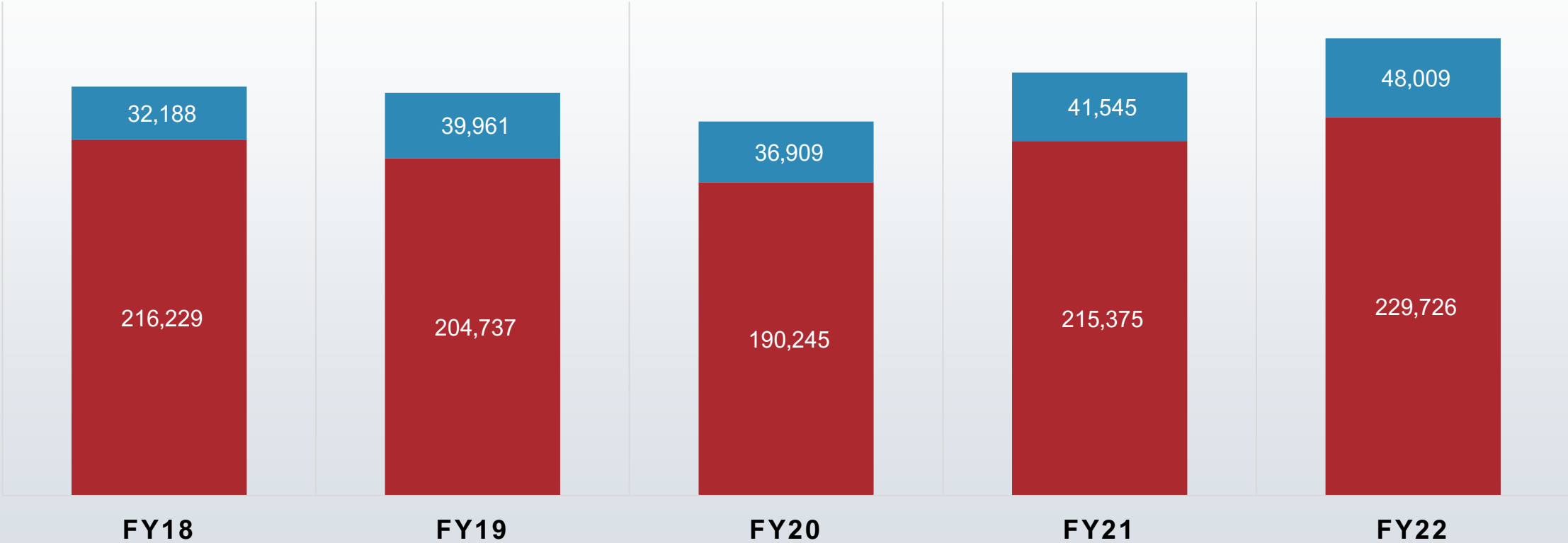




# Investigations and Alternative Response case numbers increased in FY22

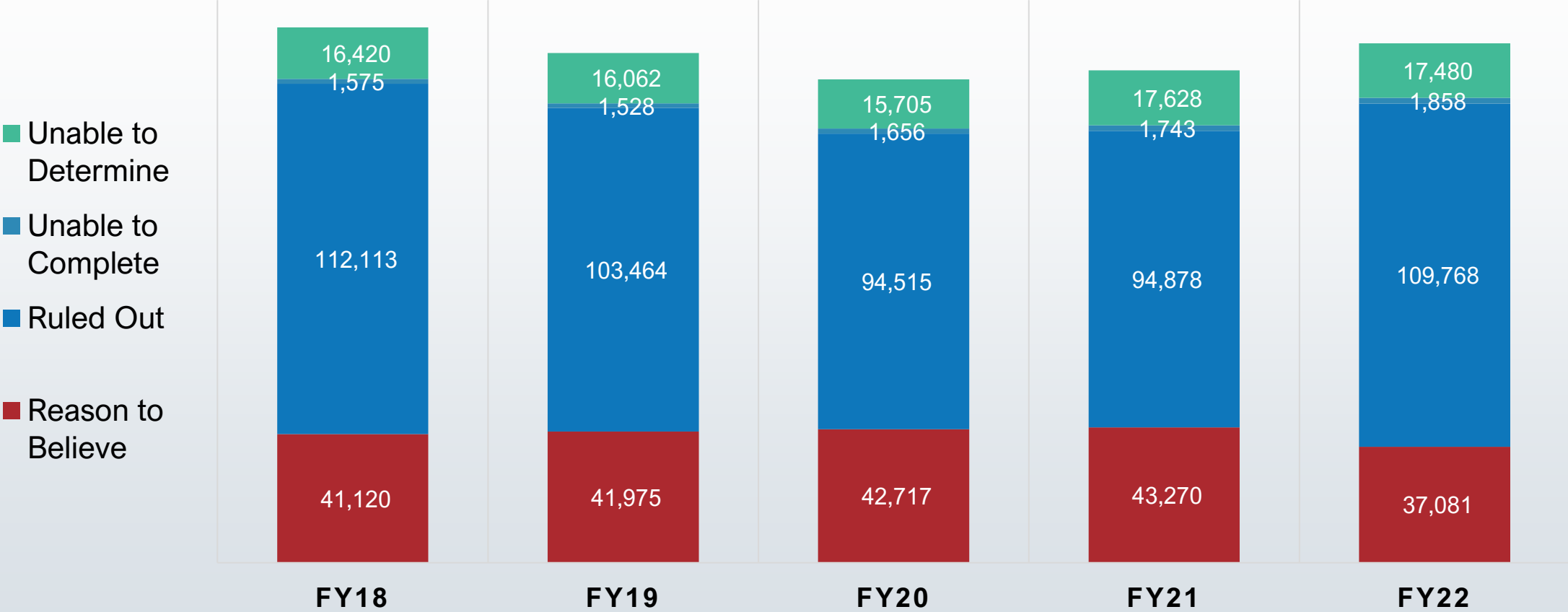

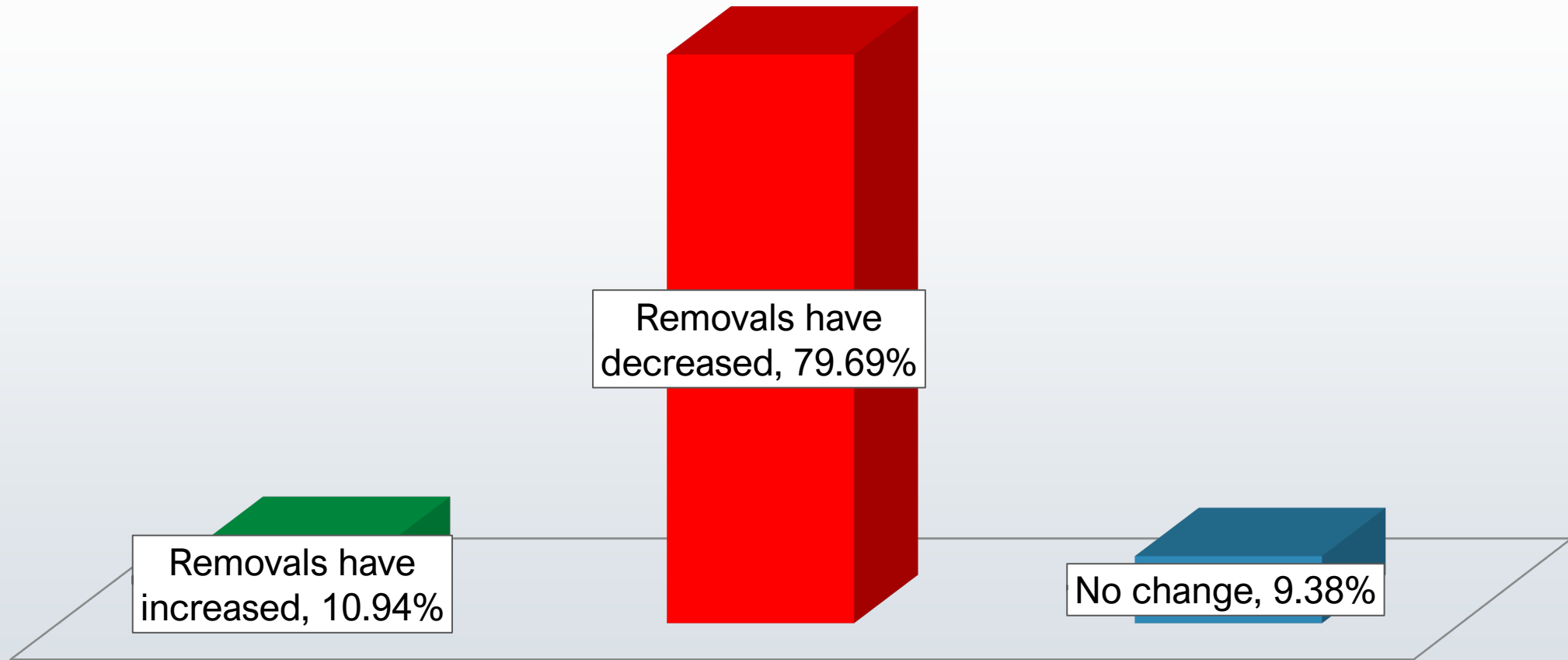

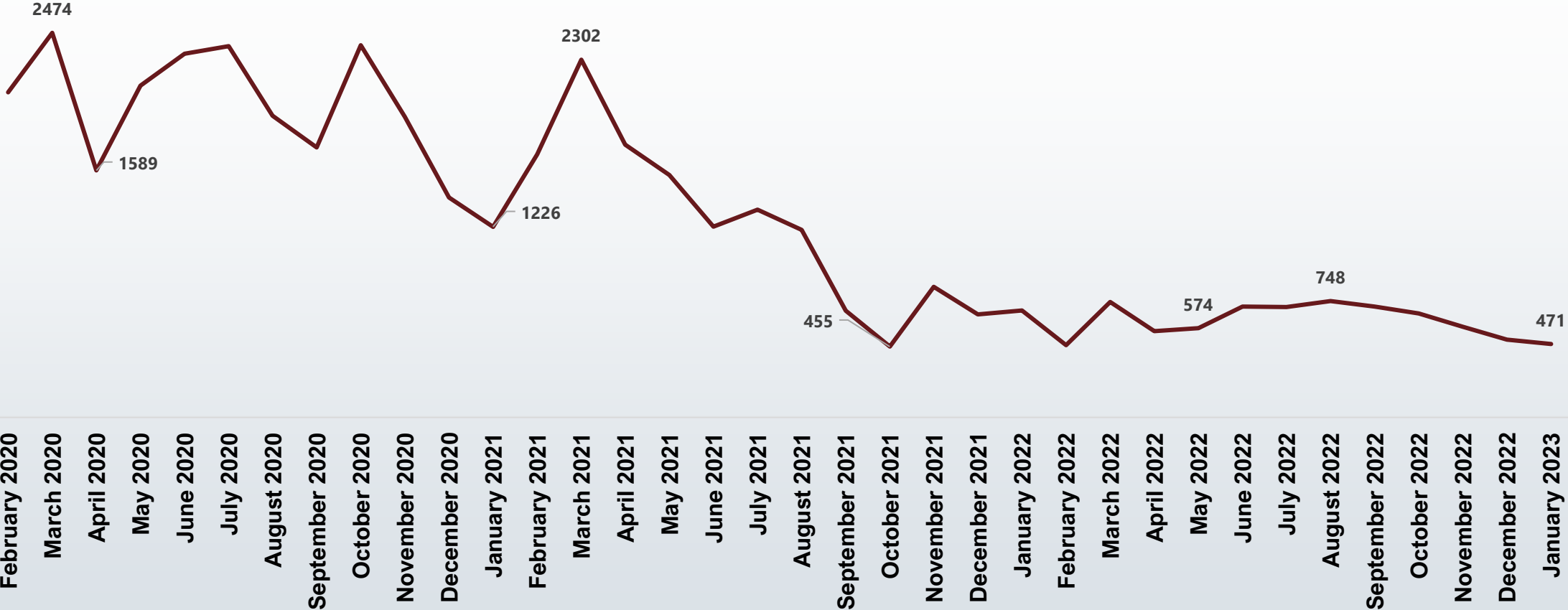

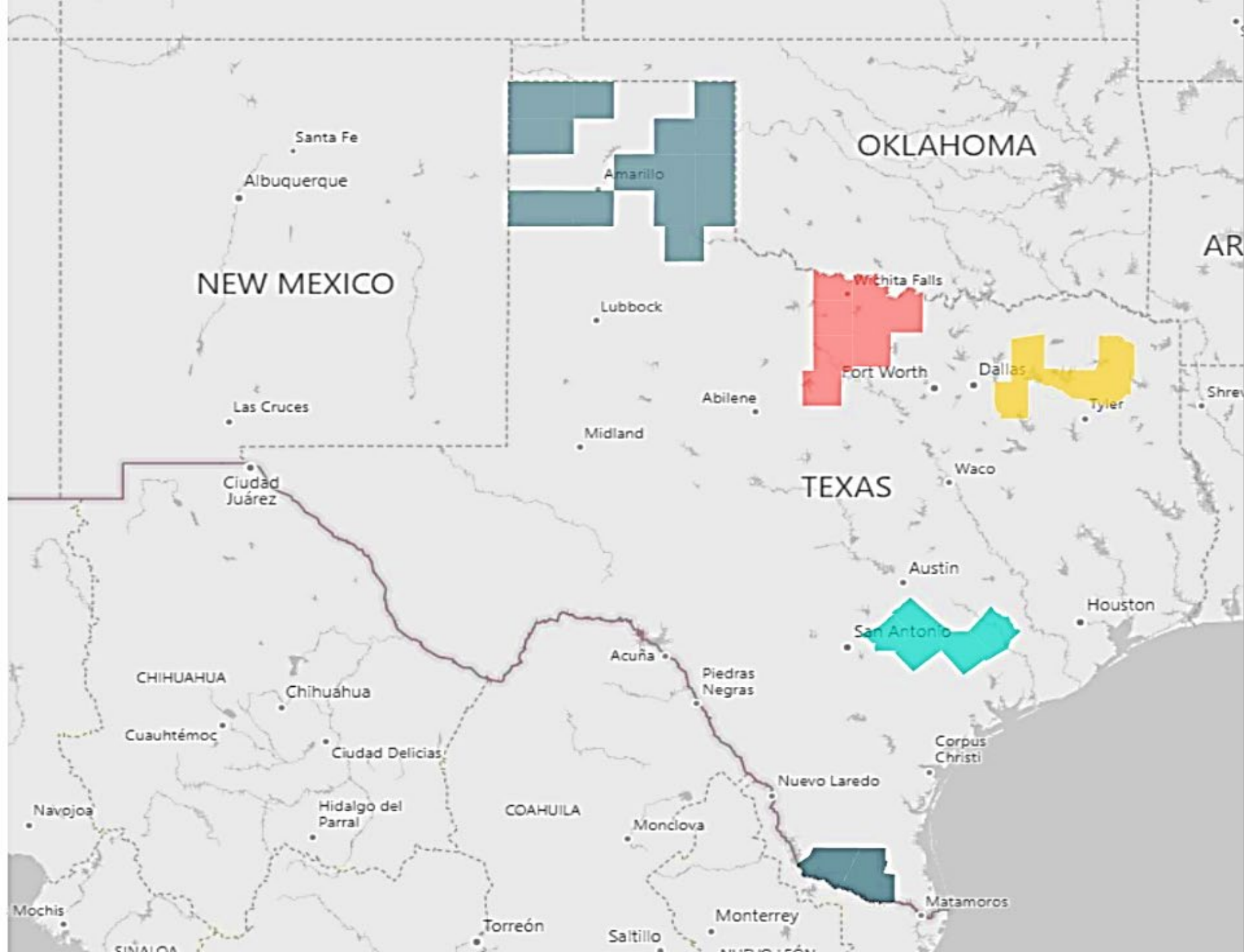
# New case filings for all Child Protection Courts (CPCs)

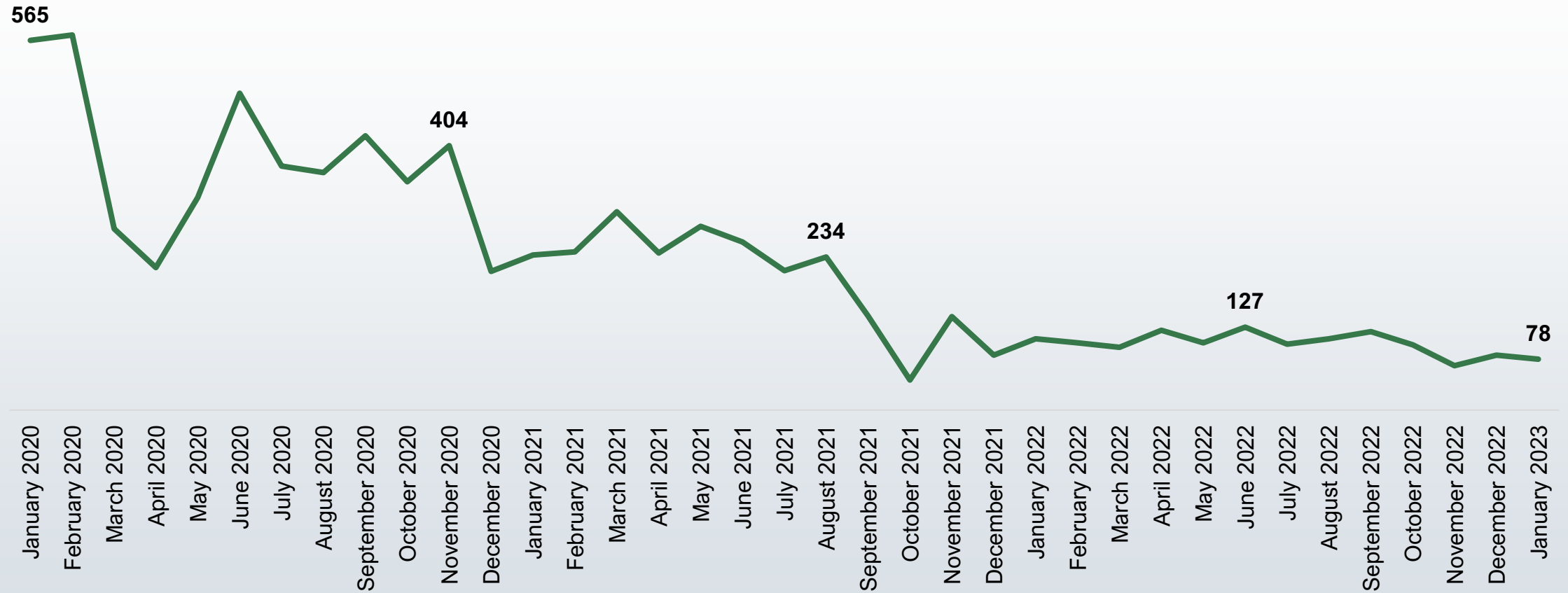

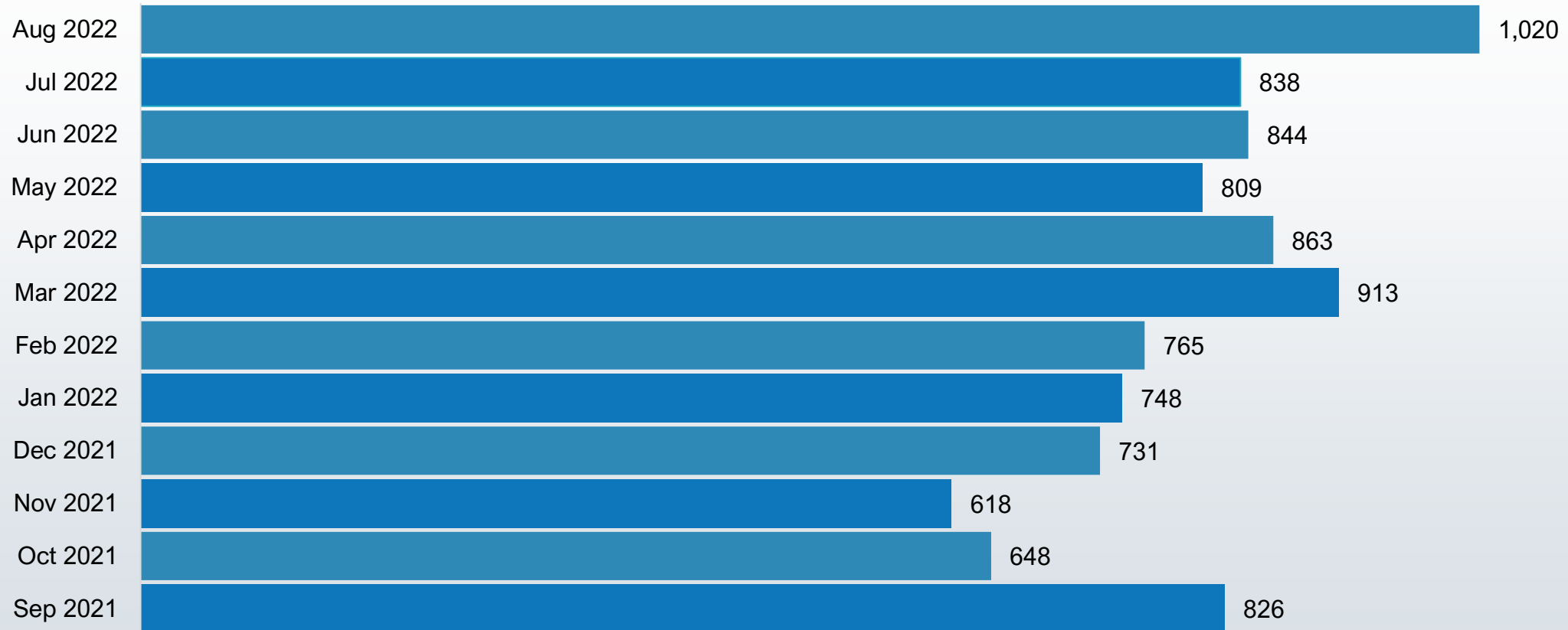

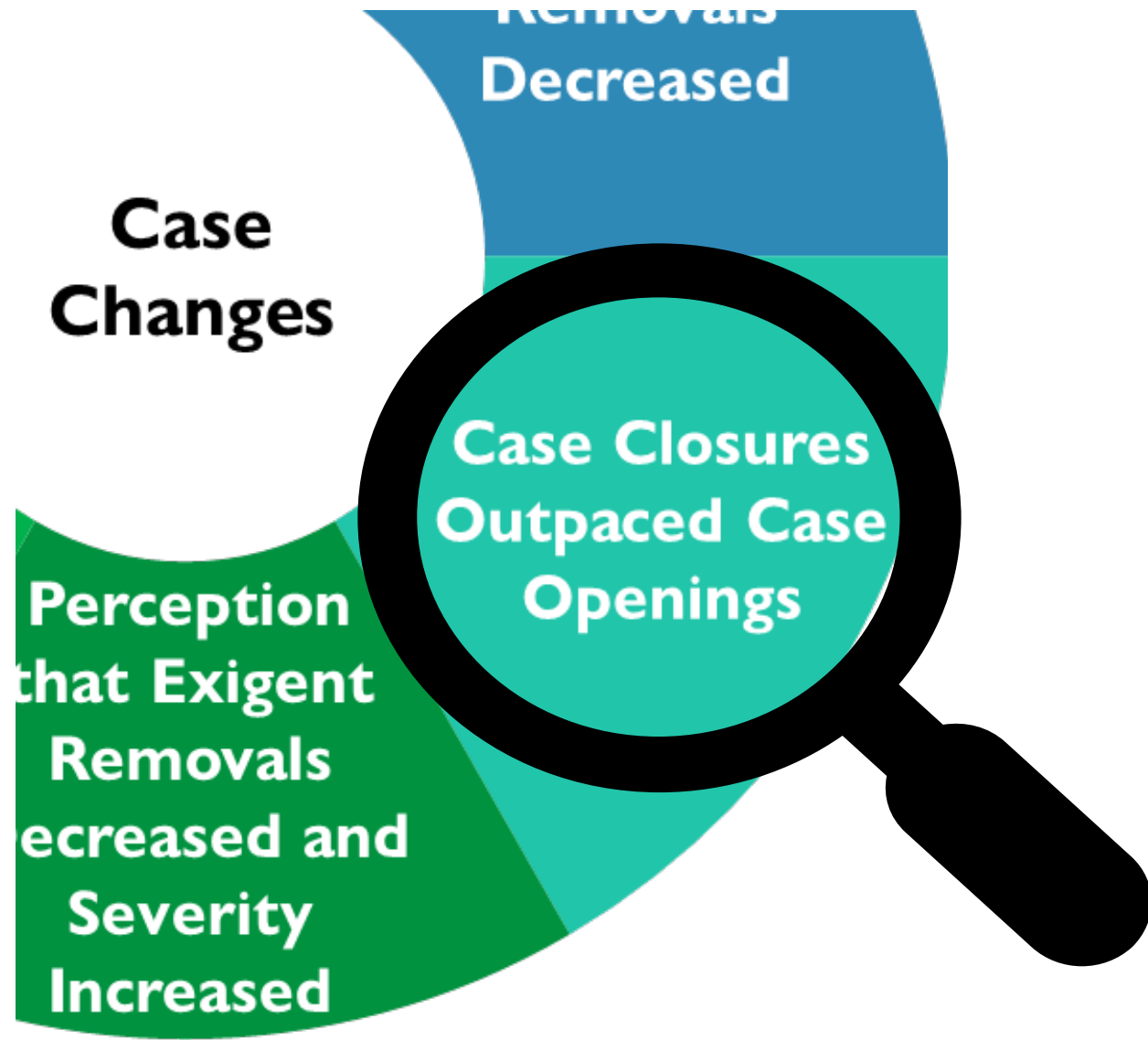
Children Removed From Home



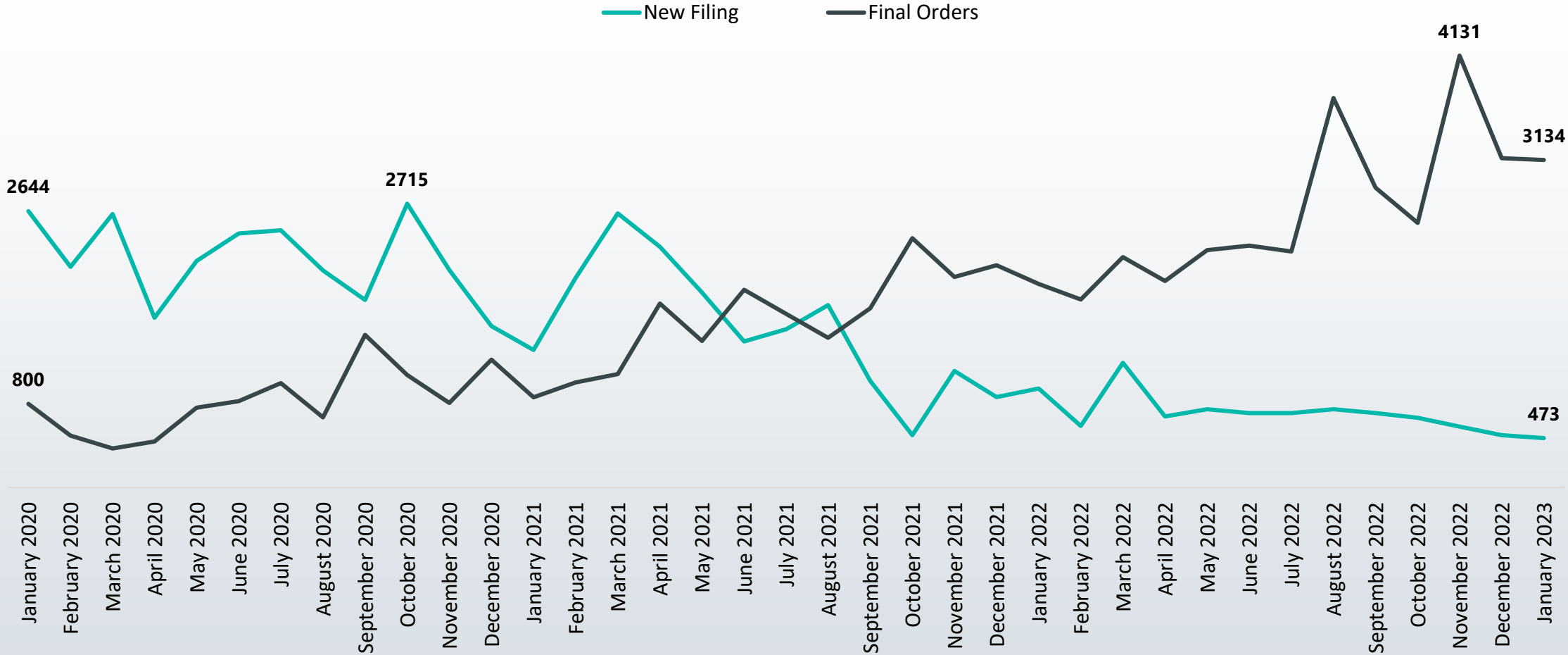
# FY 22 Removals

FY22 Removals by Month



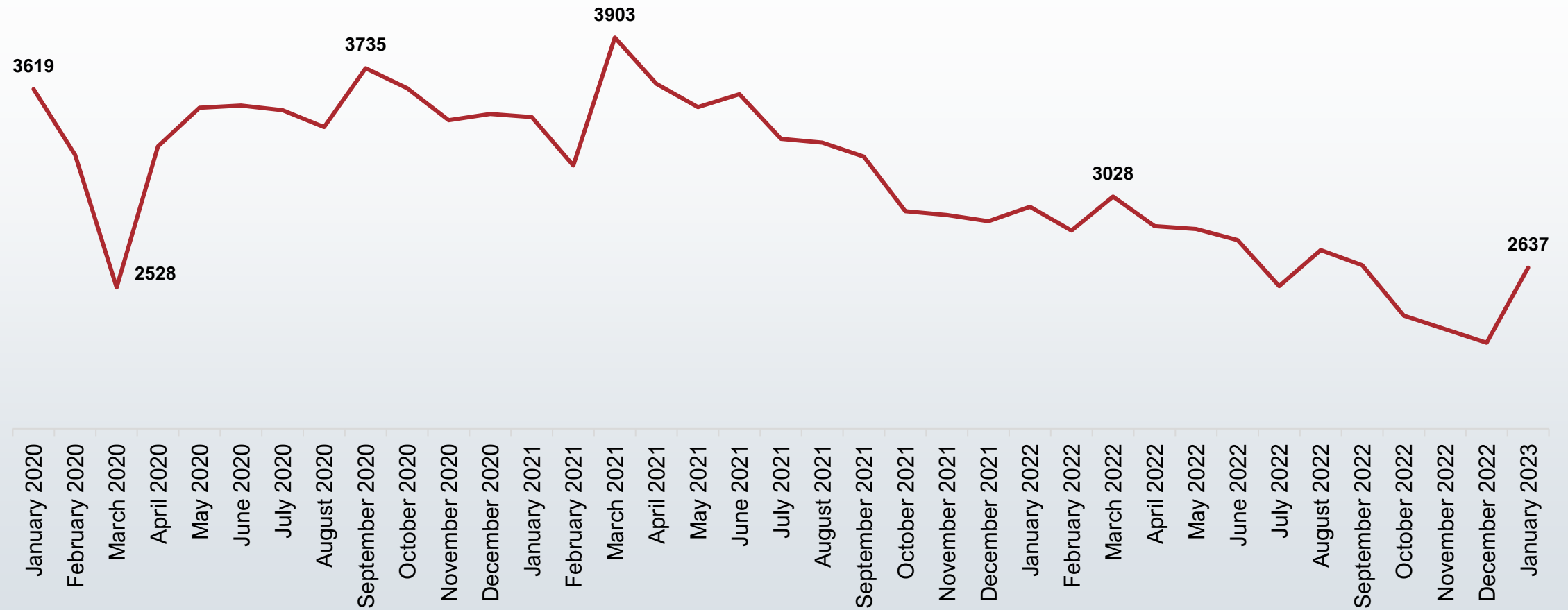

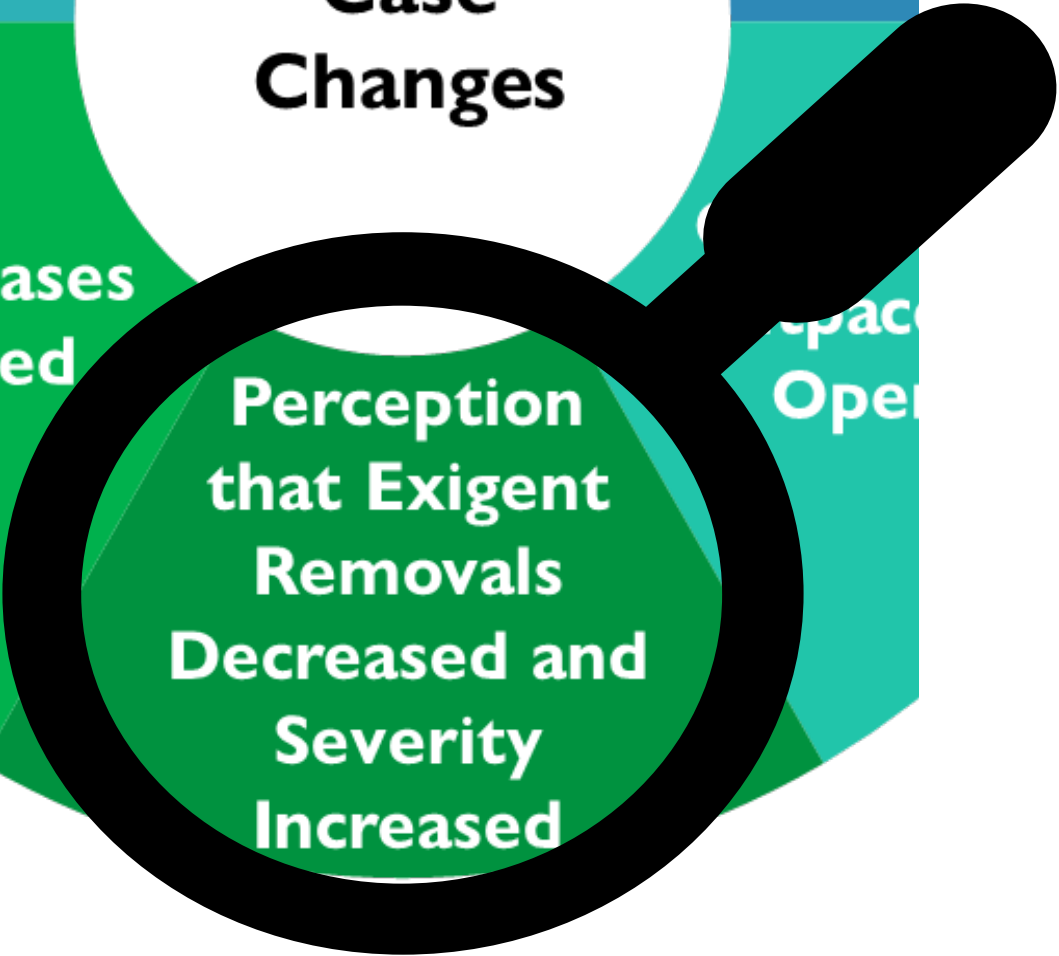

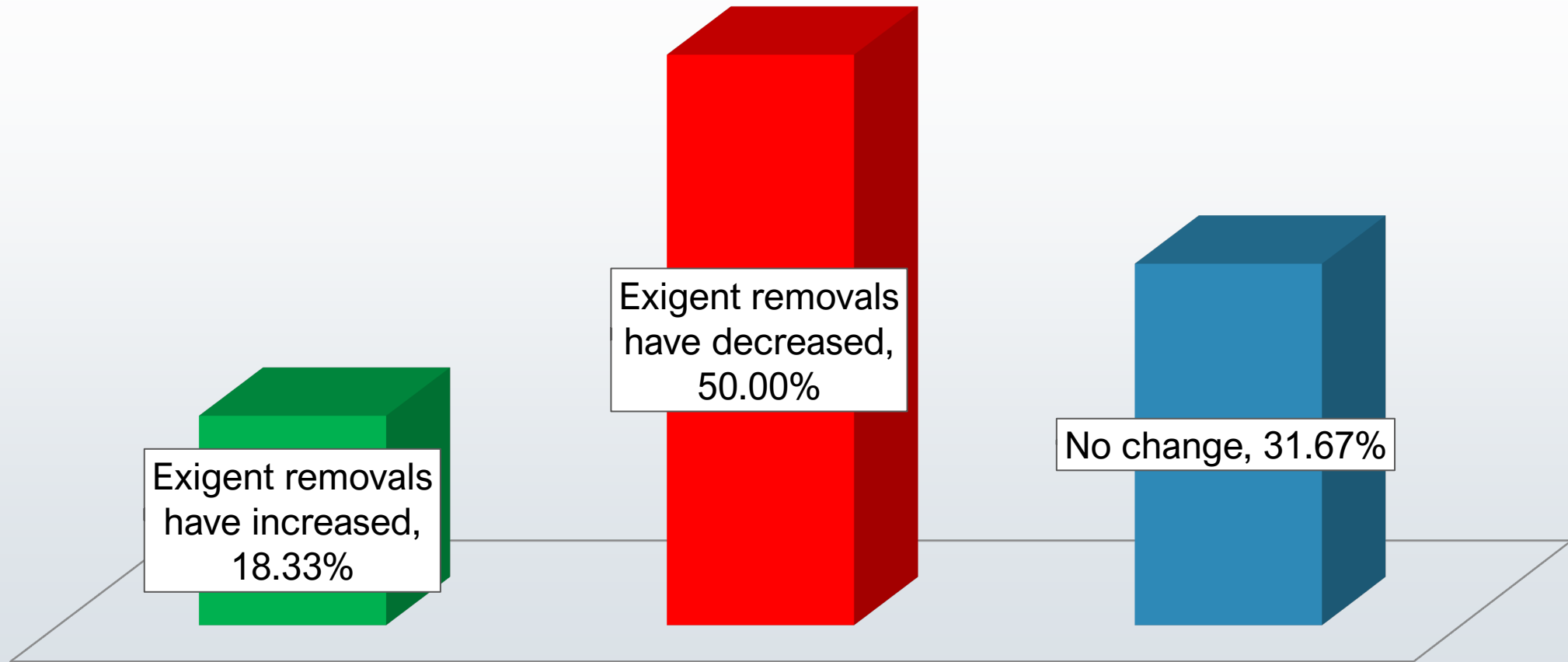

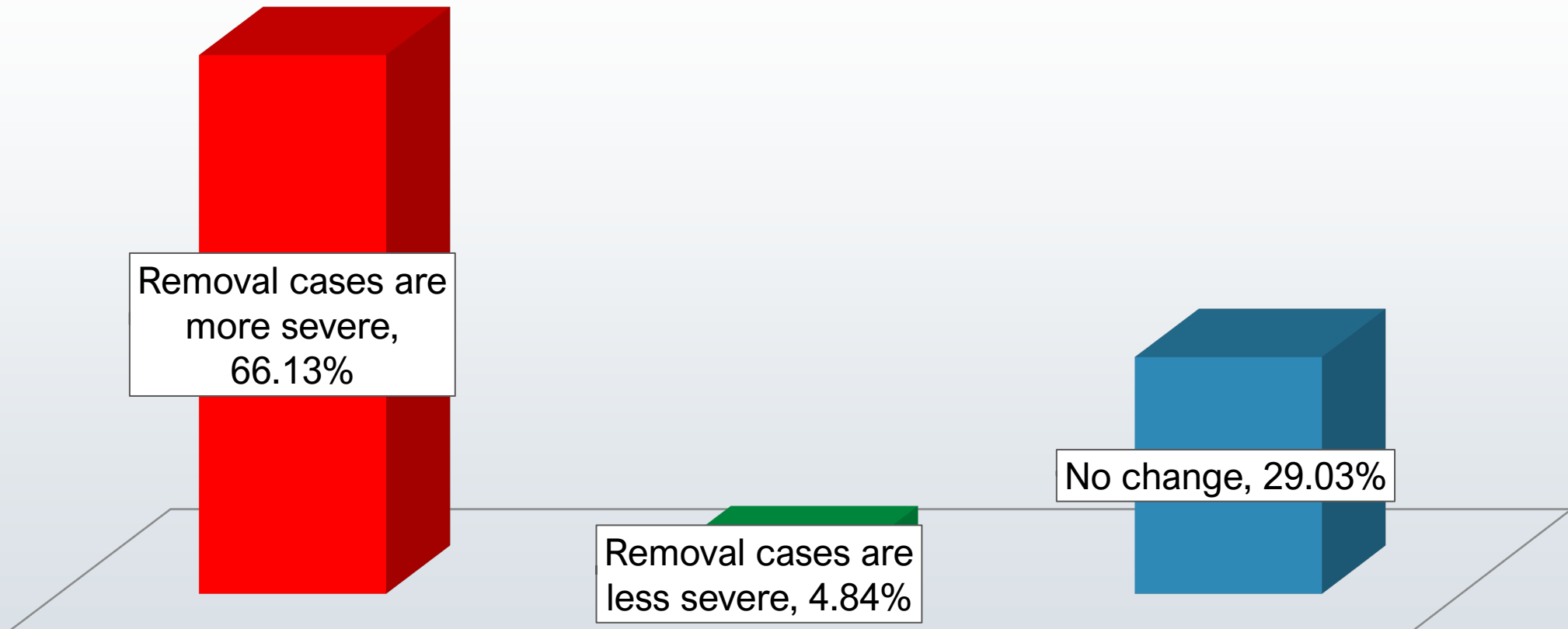
# CWJC Survey: In the last year, what change have you seen in exigent removals (removal prior to a court order) in your jurisdiction?

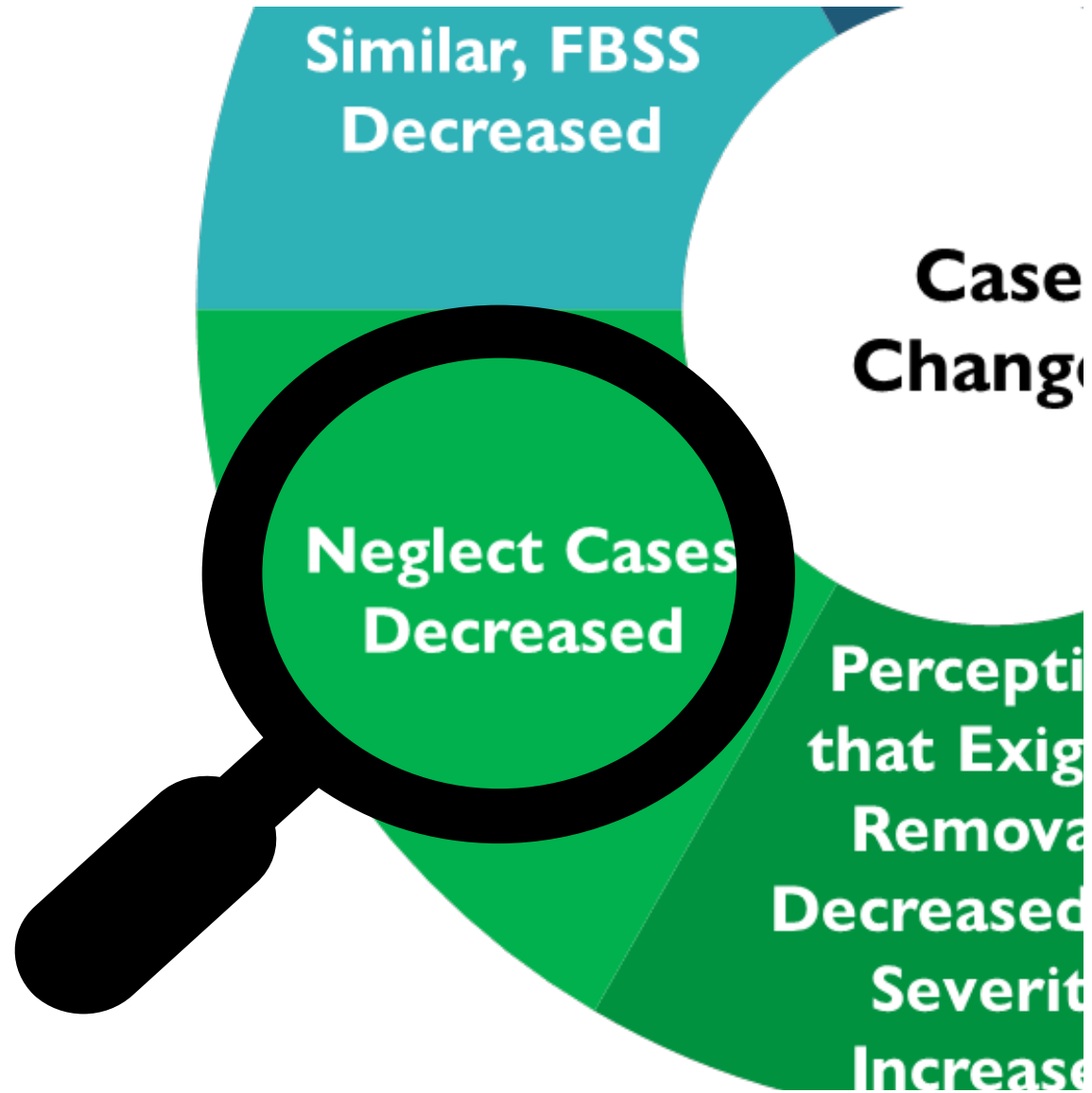

# CWJC Survey: What change have you seen in the severity of cases where removal is requested?

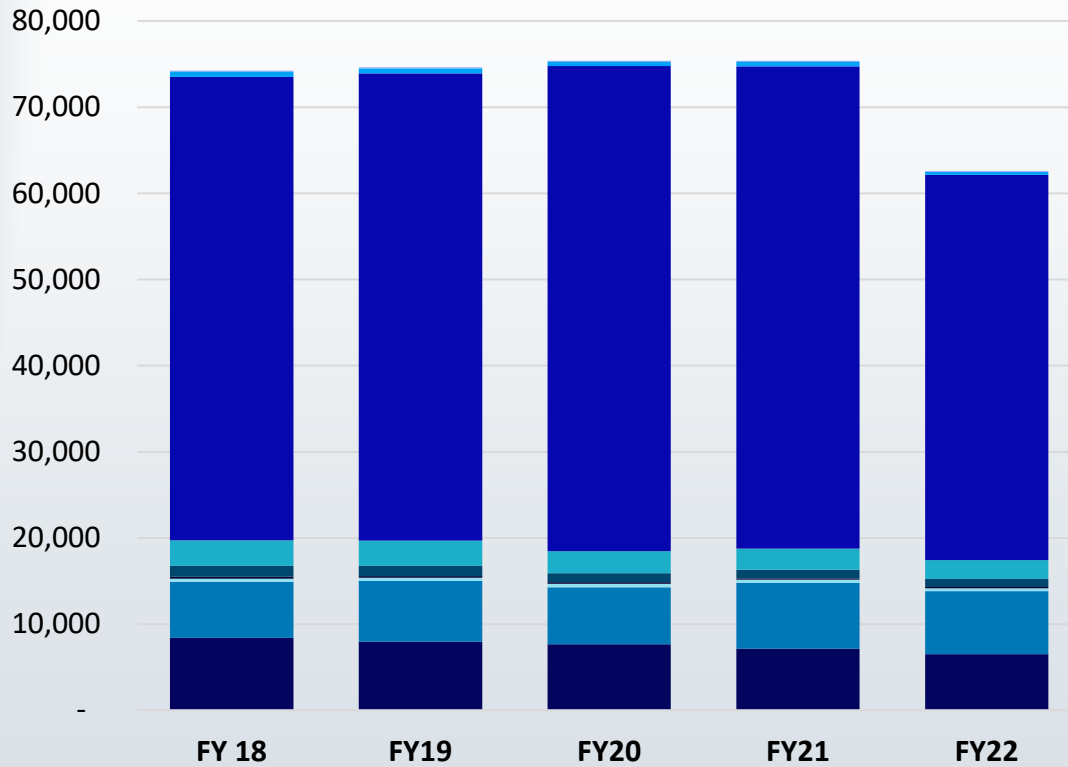

# Confirmed allegations decreased in FY22 across all allegation types except Abandonment

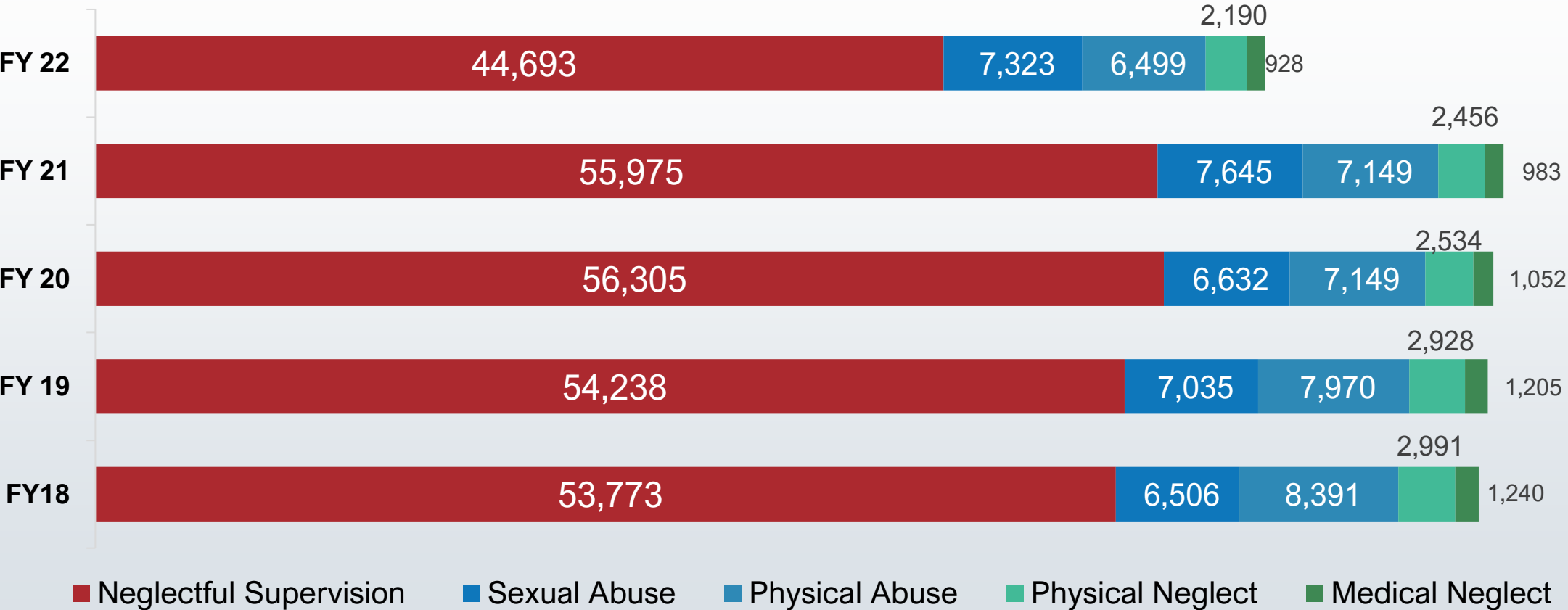

Allegations for Confirmed Victims

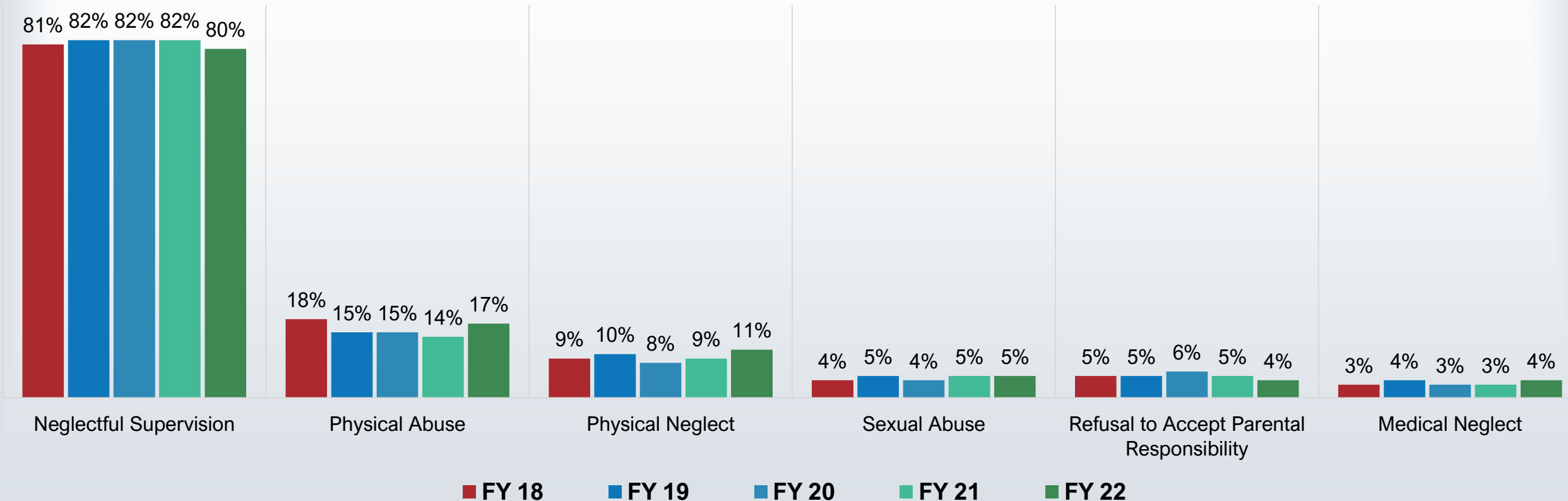

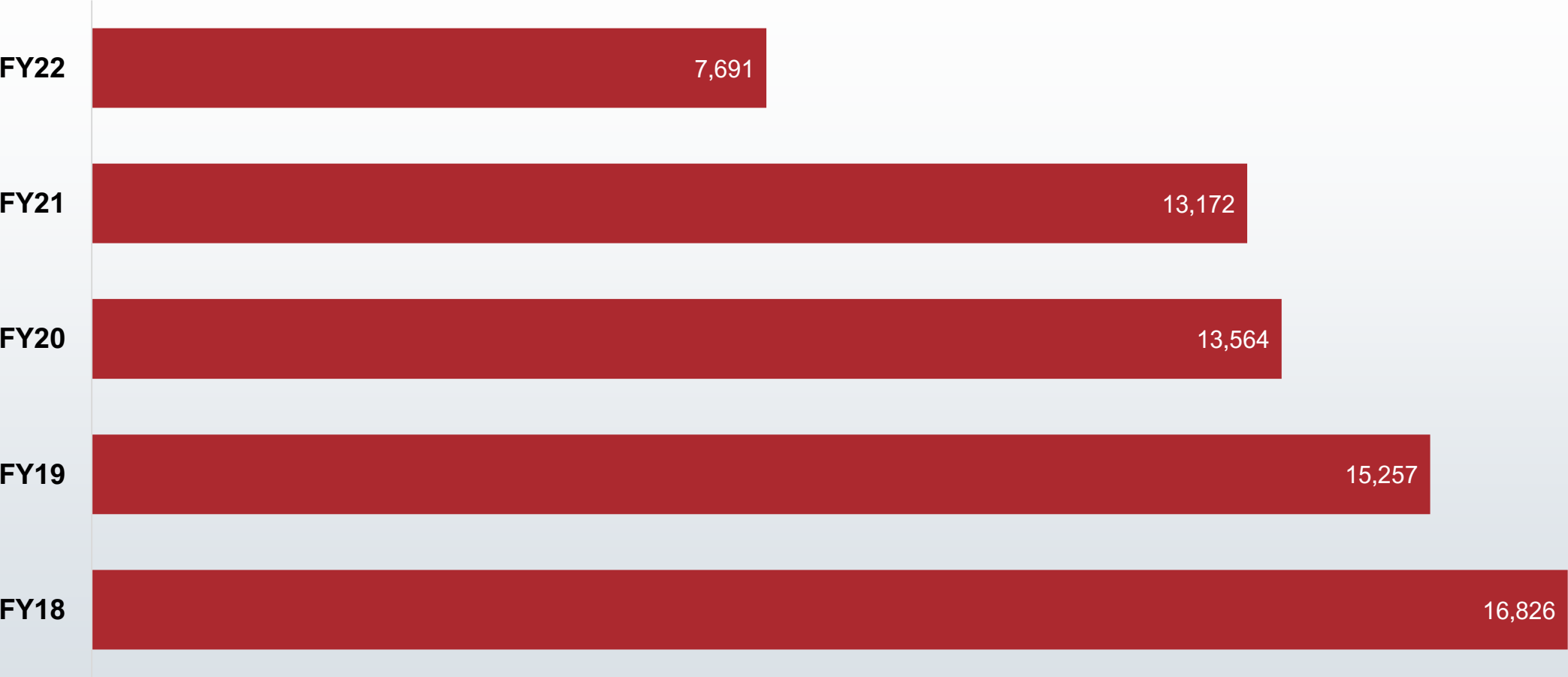
# The proportion of removal reasons was similar in FY22 compared to prior fiscal years

 Note: Children can have more than one removal reason



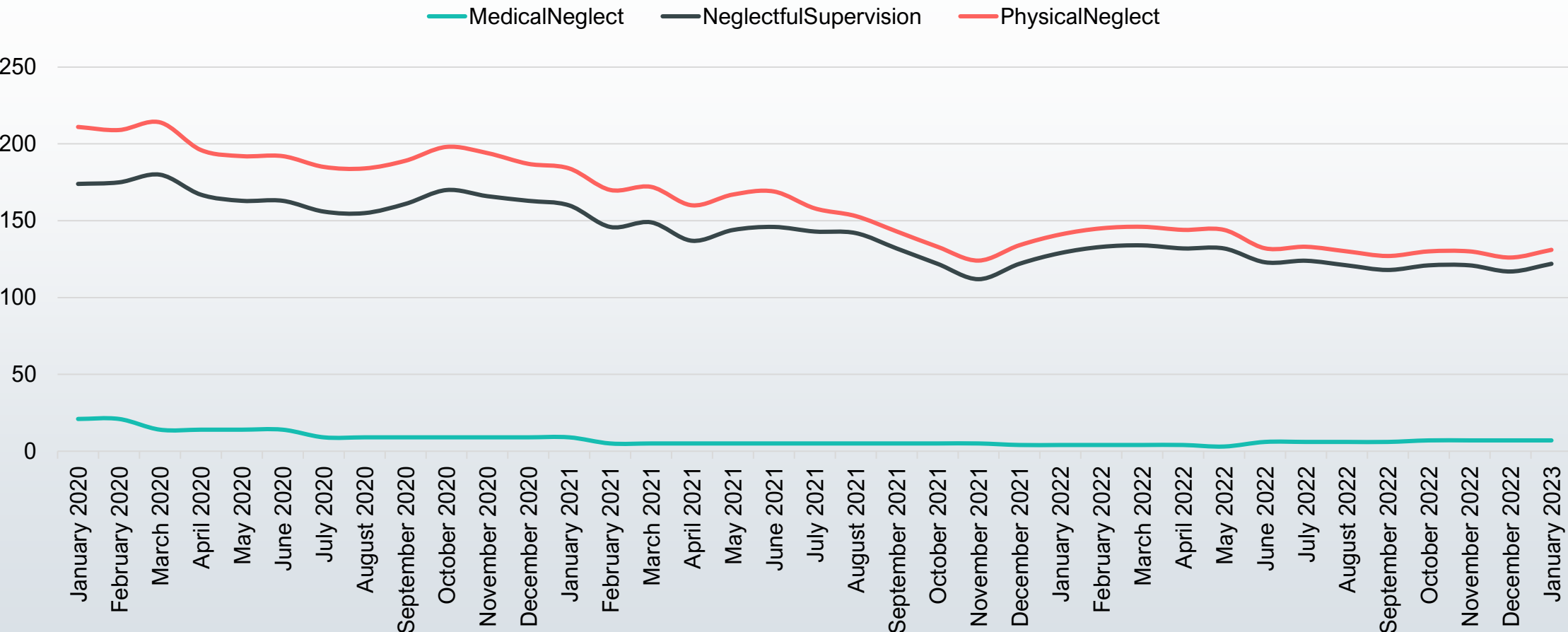

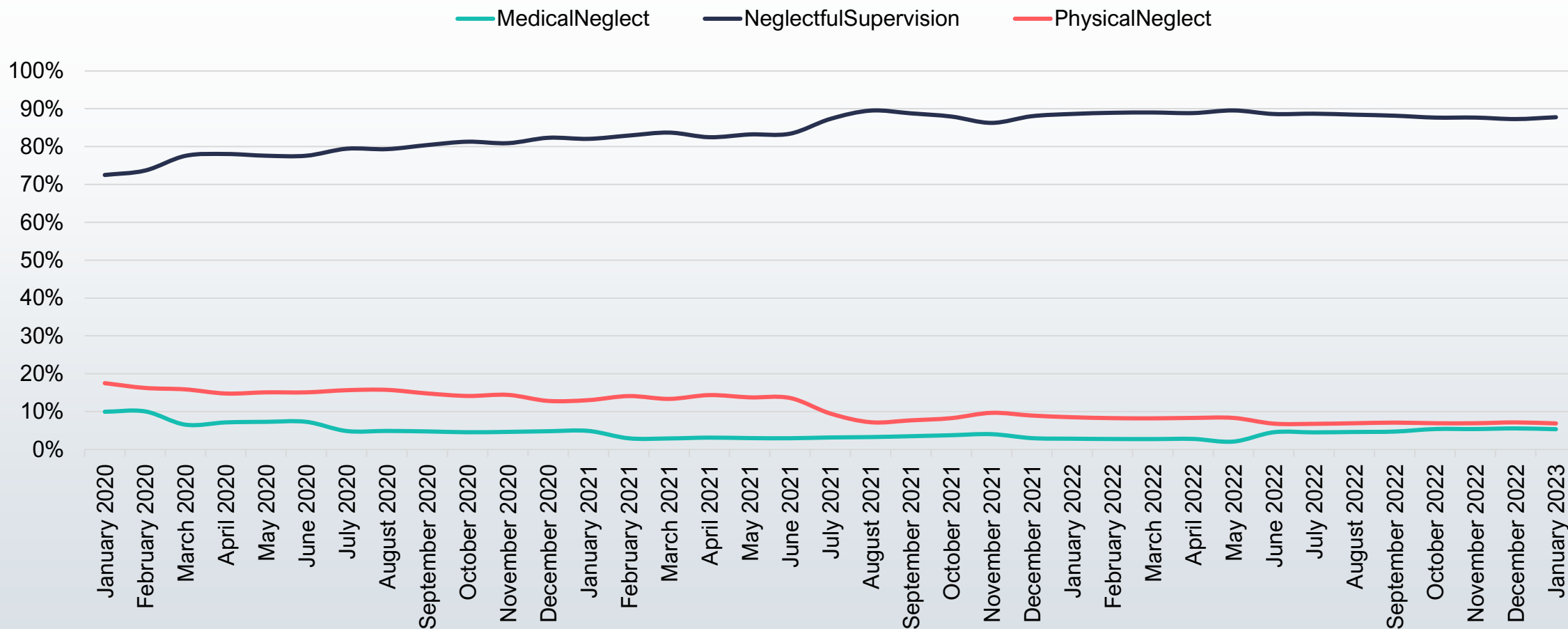
# Neglect cases for the 5 selected CPCs

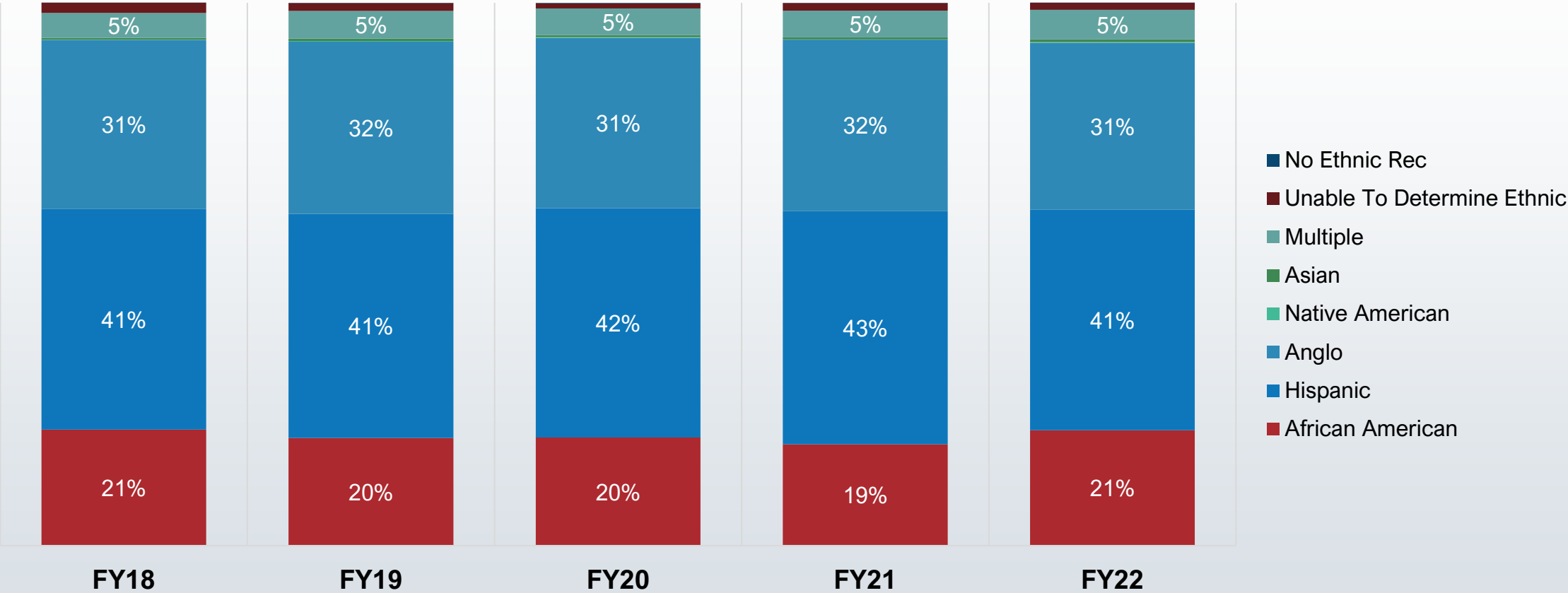


# Neglect categories as a percentage of the total neglect case for 5 selected CPCs

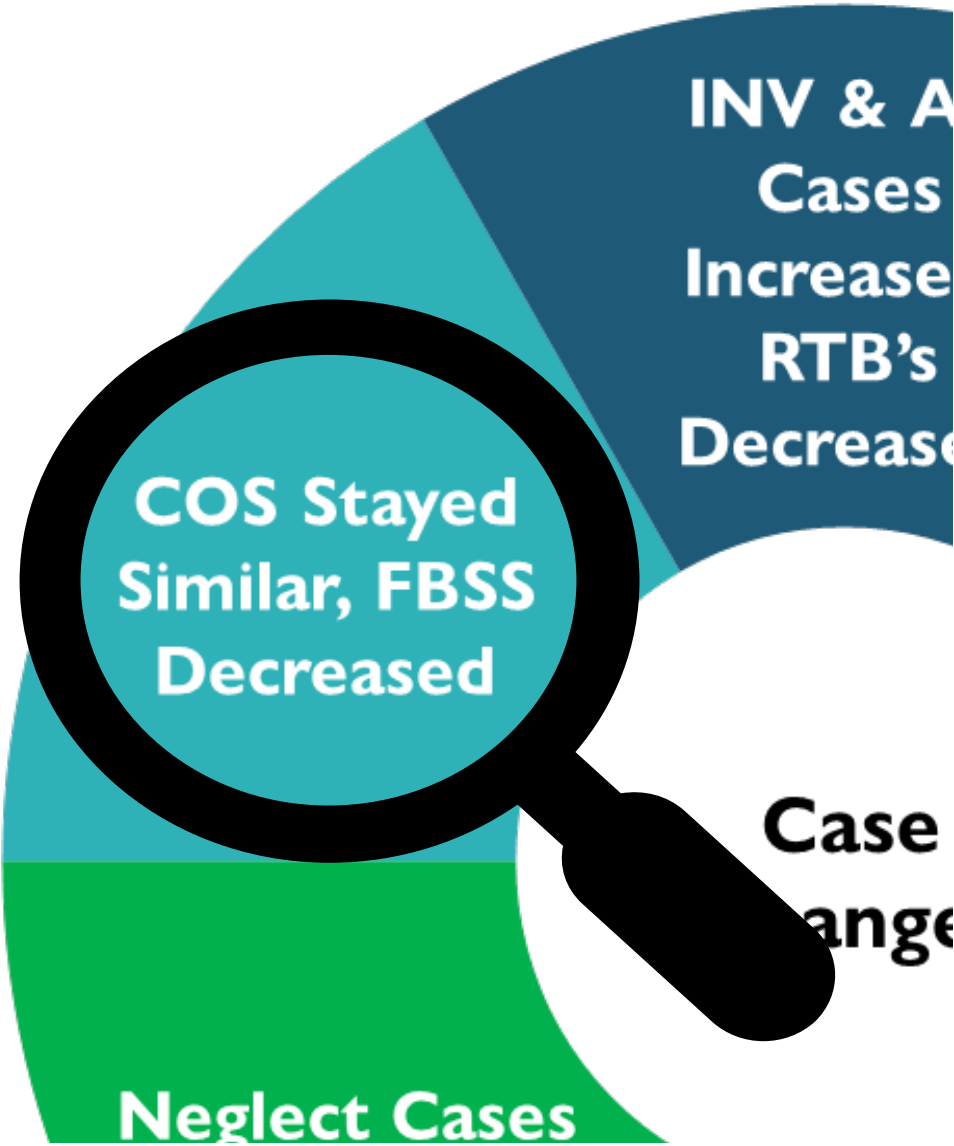


# The proportion of Removals by Race/Ethnicity has stayed similar across fiscal years

Removals by Race/Ethnicity

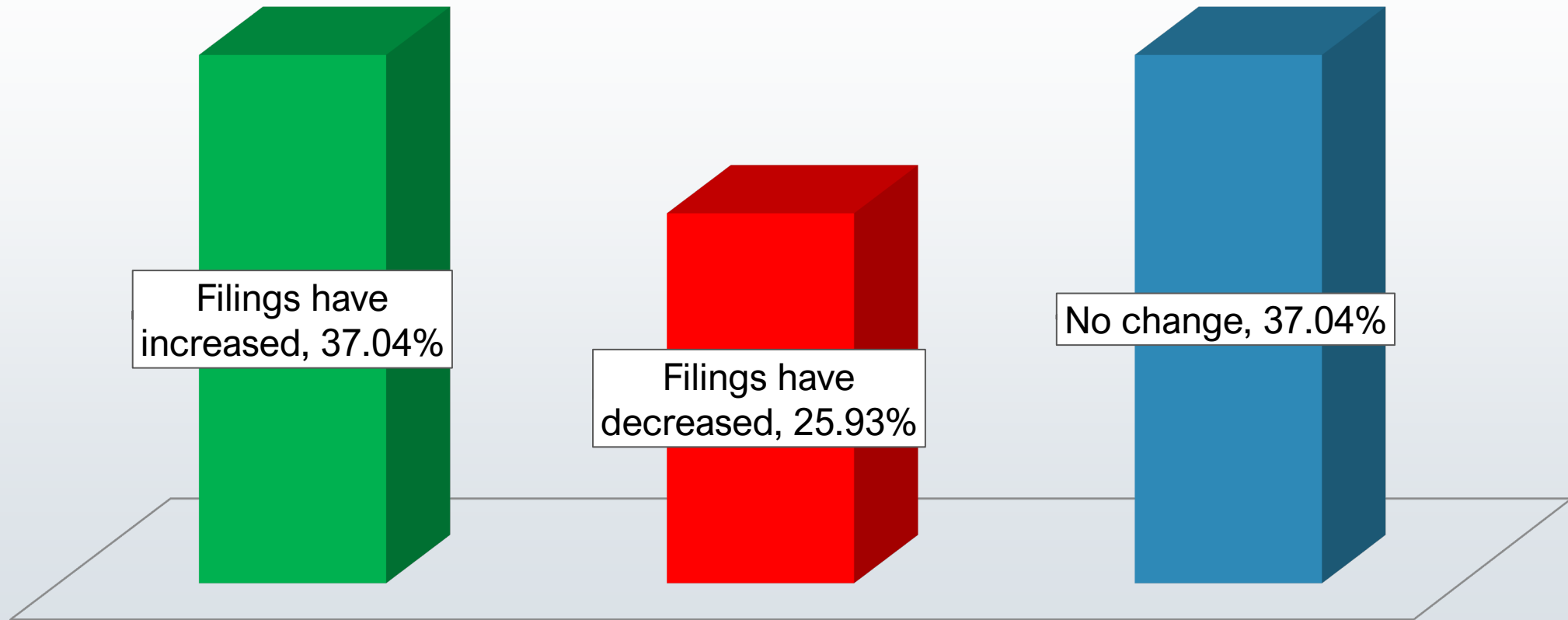

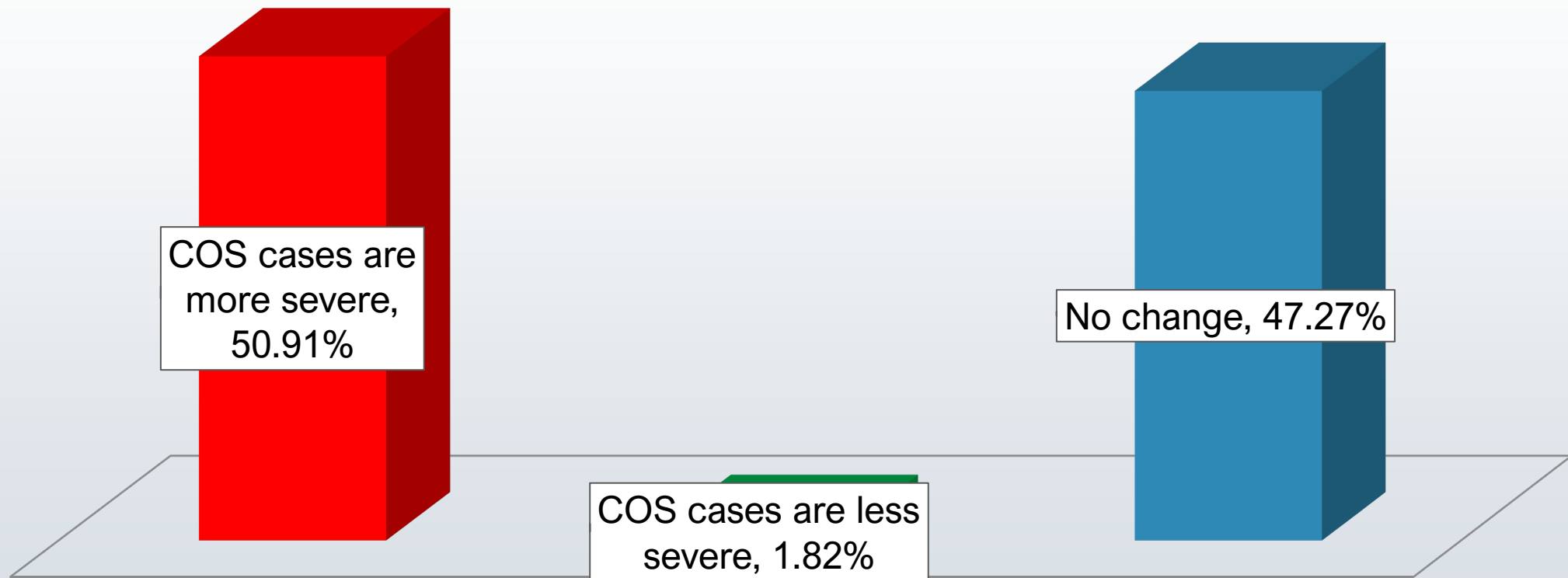
# CWJC Survey: In the last year, how have the filings of COS/MTP cases changed in your jurisdiction?

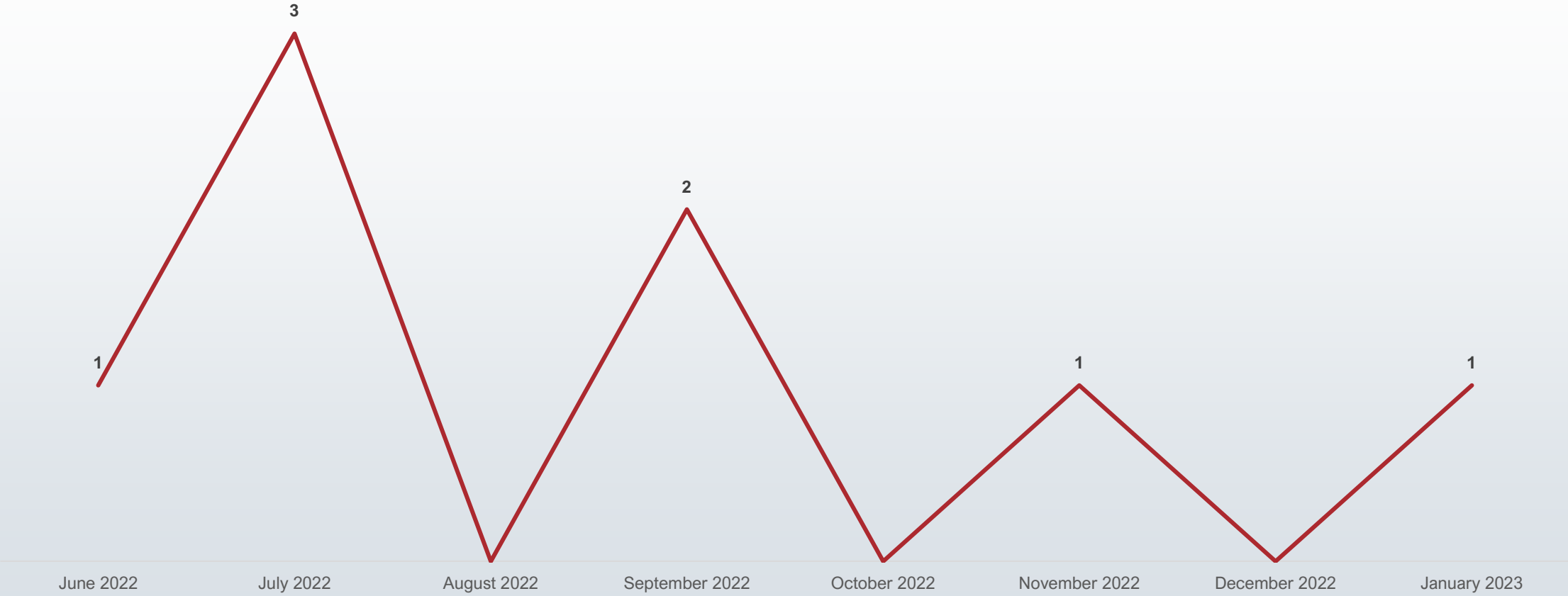
# CWJC Survey: Have you seen a change in the severity of cases where COS/MTP is requested?

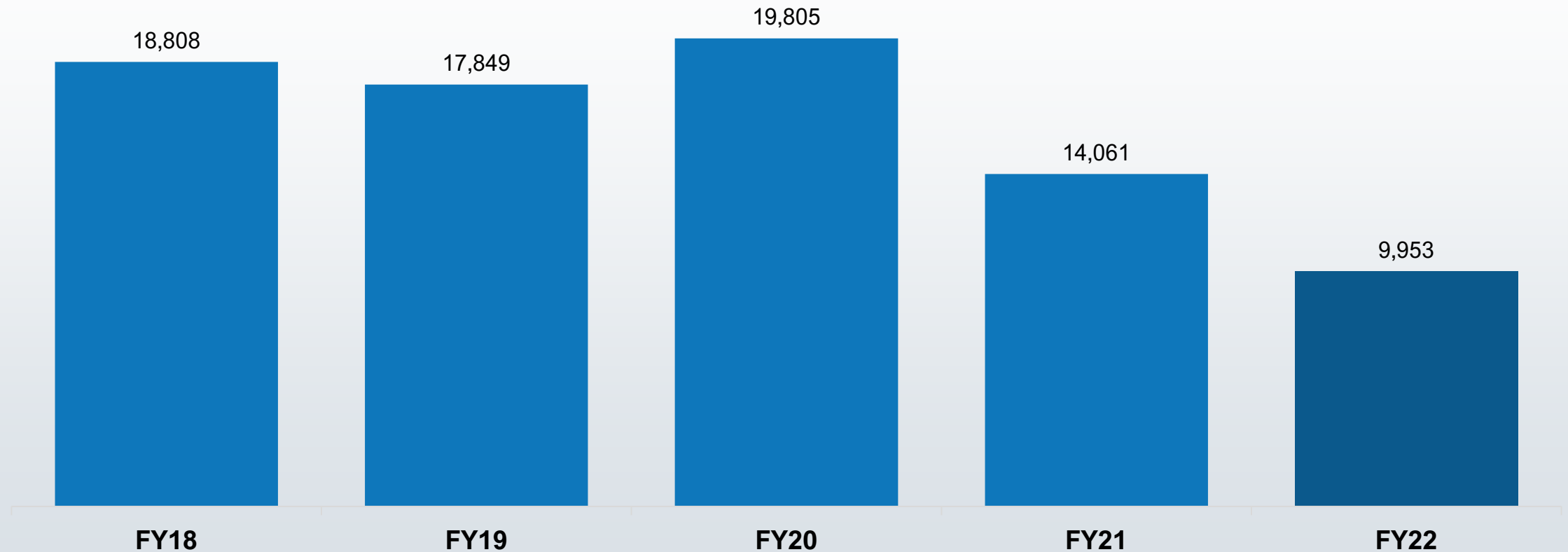
# COS/MTP hearings for 5 selected CPCs
